

As Pier 57 starts its transformation into a new waterfront hotspot, the interim space is already being used for an array of events and art exhibitions. Currently on display, "Magic Carpet" by CHURTICHAGA + QUADRA-SALCEDO is a hanging "garden" of 36 brightly colored shipping containers along the ceiling of the pier's main structure. Inspired by both the area's architectural history and future plans (the pier is being turned into a mall made of shipping containers), the installation transforms the utilitarian cargo holders into hanging sculptures suspended ten feet from the ground over visitors'


